3. What was the scope of the projects?
4. What was the cost per project?
5. What parts of the projects were completed?
6. How much was paid for these projects?
7. How much is still owed for these projects?
8. Is it government's intention to complete these projects? And if not, why not?
9. What is the cost to complete these projects?
