The Parliament of Sint Maarten in its meeting of today, January 29, 2015

CONSIDERING :

- * that the drastic decrease in oil prices around the world including the Caribbean has led to the lowering of fuel prices across the board by 30-50%
- * that the cost to consumers for the consumption of energy is quite high due to the fuel clause charged by GEBE
- * that the general public has been crying out for relief
- * that the government owned company GEBE has stated that decreases will take place, but slowly
- * That the Prime Minister told Parliament that he is in favour of passing on the decreases in oil prices to the consumers immediately

RESOLVES:

To request government as shareholder of GEBE to instruct the management of GEBE to take the necessary steps to immediately reduce the fuel clause for all consumers,
