The Parliament of Sint Maarten in its meeting of today, March 10, 2016;

Considering:


- The unemployment rate of the youth of Sint Maarten between the ages 18 and 25;
- The need to have options for young people;
- The fact that the national ordinance mandatory service is still applicable on St. Maarten;

Resolves:

- To request the Minister of General Affairs to prepare the necessary guidelines and make the necessary facilities available to start recruiting the unemployed youngsters born in St Maarten between the ages of 18 and 25, for the mandatory service, starting January 2017;

and proceeds to the order of the day.
