The Parliament of Sint Maarten in its meeting of today, June 30, 2021,

Considering the letter from the former Minister of Justice to the CCSU dated June 28th, 2019, and the documents referenced in said letter,

Also considering the letter received by Parliament from the union NAPB on June 22nd, 2021,

Having debated the draft budget for the fiscal year 2021 in the Central Committee and Public meetings,

Cognizant of the fact that the legal positions of a large number of employees in the Ministry of Justice have not yet been regulated,

Desirous of regulating the legal positions of all the employees in the Ministry of Justice before the end of 2022,

- Resolves to request the Government to finalize the updated "rechtpositie" for KPSM and
 any other applicable Justice Ministry personnel, in order to calculate the retroactive
 payments finalized, and report to parliament with these within three (3) months of today's
 date;
- 2. Resolves to request the Government to include all outstanding amounts due to the Justice Ministry's personnel since 2010 that have not been paid out as yet and which are not included in the budget of 2021, in the budget of 2022 and have these amounts paid out no later than December 31st, 2022,
