Draft Motion

The Parliament of St. Maarten, in its meeting of today, January <sup>e1</sup> 2022

**Considering**

That the government is in urgent need of filling its critical vacancies

That based on answers received in meetings of Parliament, the process for filling some critical vacancies has taken many months, and in some cases over a year

That the current policy for remuneration (LBHAM Bezoldiging) with regards to promoted civil servants (article 8) omits a fixed figure for what the percent-range increase should be in the event of promotion

That the Prime Minister has indicated her intention to fully address the number servants in an "aanloopschaal" for more than 1 year, which appears to go against the idea of the use of such a scale as prescribed in Article 3 of the Bezoldiging LBHAM

**Declares**

That the Parliament of St. Maarten support the governments and Honorable Prime Ministers efforts to fill their critical vacancies in 2022, and the Prime Ministers commitment to address civil servant issues with the "aanloopschaal"


**Resolves**

For there to be a fast-track departmental policy created for the handling of critical vacancies to ensure that they can be filled within a period of 60 days between when the vacancy is published to when the person is contracted

For the Minister of AZ to have the ministry review article 8 of the LBHAM Bezoldiging, and consider adding a fixed range to reduce ambiguity in the application of this law,

For the PM to report back in writing to the Parliament regarding the above resolutions within 2 months
