Draft Motion

The Parliament of Sint Maarten, in its meeting of today, January 21, 2022,

CONSIDERING:


- That for the past many years, Turning Point has been providing assistance to citizens affected by substance abuse.
- That through the assistance of Turning Point many individuals and by extension their families and the community as a whole have benefitted from the care provided.
- That as a result of the COVID 19 pandemic, there has been an increase in the demand for care provided by Turning Point.
- That in recent discussions with Dr. Lloyd Richardson of Turning Point it was disclosed that there is a dire need for an increase in the subsidy presently provided to the organization to avoid them having to either close their doors or in having to turn away many persons who would need their services.


RESOLVES:

1. To request the Council of Ministers to prepare an amendment to the 2022 draft budget, once approved, showing an increase to the subsidy for Turning Point, under budget post 44301-5209 from the amount of Naf.1.240.434,00 to Naf.1.600.000,00 and present same to Parliament within 60 days for its consideration and approval, and goes over to the order of the day.


